
Perth Leisure Pool was closed for 7 days in November for significant maintenance works

The pool at Breadalbane Community Campus was closed for approximately 3 weeks due to boiler failure.


Severe weather in Q4 resulted in the enforced closure of a number of venues and outdoor facilities and reduced user uptake.

Fitness membership sales were 9% higher than in 2016-17 and member usages reflected this.


1. Number of overall attendances at LAL venues



2. Number of unique users of LAL venues.




3. Number of overall attendances of concessionary sport and fitness activities






5. Number of overall attendances of health improvement programmes










11. Number of progressive pathways development from local voluntary sports clubs into performance sport programmes






12. Number of Community Sports Hubs under development








16. Number of children and young people actively volunteering in sport & leading to an accredited wider achievement award





18. Outdoor Education centres occupation as percentage of total availability - Blackwater




